**An Update on RiteCare of Minnesota
Effective March 1, 2026**

Starting March 1, 2026, the administration and day-to-day operations of RiteCare of Minneapolis-St. Paul will be supported by the Masonic Children's Clinic for Communication Disorders (MMCCCD).

RiteCare's mission remains the same: providing financial assistance to families so children can access speech and language therapy services.
